Jonah has performed with the Johnstown Symphony, the Syracuse Symphoria, River City Brass Band, Balcony Big Band, Murphy's Music Center Jazz Orchestra, The Jazz Conspiracy, and has toured with the world-renowned brass ensemble Tim Zimmerman and the King's Brass for six seasons. Jonah is currently the Assistant Director of the King's Brass and has also worked with D&G Entertainment and Design, JMMD Entertainment, and at Camp of the Woods in Speculator, New York.

In addition to his busy touring schedule, Jonah continues to actively freelance in the Pittsburgh area and most recently completed a runout of the Adams Family Musical. He is also an avid arranger and has written several arrangements for the King's Brass and Spring Arbor University.
