♦ Students may wish to consider receiving a flu shot during Fall semester, as flu has prevented some from flying on the date of scheduled departure in the past. The flu season in some parts of the world includes May, June, and July. Students can receive the Flu vaccine at HHWS at no cost to students.

In addition, the Center for Disease Control (CDC) recommends the Hepatitis A series as well as other immunizations to travelers going to many locations.
