General Education Requirements

If the MACRAO agreement is satisfied, general education requirements are met when transferring to Spring Arbor University. If MACRAO is **not** fulfilled, the following courses are needed to meet general education requirements for Elementary Education -- Early Childhood endorsement (ZA) at Spring Arbor University. A **maximum of 80 hours may be transferred from JC to SAU**. General Education requirements are not applicable to post bachelor students.

SAU's School of Education (SOE) is approved by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) for certification in Michigan. To certify in Elementary Education (K-5) with an Early Childhood Education Endorsement (ZS), candidates must complete Option II-Elementary Education as well as either a major in Early Childhood or a minor in Early Childhood PLUS another minor from the list on page 3. A cumulative GPA of 2.7 is required, with a minimum grade of 2.0 or above in each course, unless otherwise noted.


