

## Wuhan University of Technology and Spring Arbor University 2+2 Agreement

This 2+2 agreement demonstrates the growing relationship between our two universities and the mutual desire to continue to build on our ten-year association. As with the general institutional agreement, the primary purpose of both institutions is exchanges that benefit our students and faculty.

This new aspect of the partnership between our two universities is based on these points of agreement:

1. The intent is to develop the structure and process for WUT students to complete two years of study at both universities and receive a bachelor's degree from SAU.
2. Students of WUT must meet the requirements of SAU to be considered for conferring its degree.
3. Students participating in this 2+2 program must meet regular admissions requirements and are responsible for their expenses as described in the attached No.1 document.
4. No assumption is made regarding the awarding of any degree by the student's home or sending institution.
5. Although WUT is not able to grant a bachelor's degree to SAU students at this time, yet SAU students can still come to WUT for a one-semester study experience. WUT will continue to explore the possibility of conferring degrees to SAU students within the regulation of the Ministry of Education of China.
6. WUT will also continue to host SAU's other cross-cultural programs as usual.
7. This agreement may be reviewed annually and may become part of the primary agreement at its next renewal.

All students receiving a degree from Spring Arbor University (SAU) must meet these requirements:

1. 124 credits minimum (from both Universities), 40 of which are upper level (300 and above)
2. Completion of a major according to the requirements stated in the SAU catalog. Transfer students must complete at least nine credits in their major (not including practice or field

experiences) at SAU. (The English Literature major requires fifteen upper level credits from SAU.)

3. Completion of the University CORE, communication skills, physical fitness and liberal arts requirements.
4. A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of "C" or 2.00 (on an A, B, C, D and F scale, and on a 4.00 scale)
5. A 2.20 GPA for courses in the major, including any transfer credits, and no 200-, 300-, or 400-level course earning a grade below a "C" will count toward the major.
6. Only courses with a grade of "C" or higher will be accepted as transfer credit.

By signing below, each institution accepts this new program as further expression of our existing agreement and acknowledges and agrees to the understandings described above. This agreement will not take effect until all the attached documents are agreed upon by SAU and WUT.
