Program Outcomes Report for CACREP Accredited Programs

The Spring Arbor University Master of Arts in Counseling Program (MAC) is housed in the School of Social Sciences. Both the Clinical Mental Health Counseling and the School Counseling Programs are CACREP accredited since July 2016. The following information is organized by CACREP-accredited program areas and reflects data for 2023-2024.

Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CMHC)

The CMHC program is a 60-credit-hour program which includes a 100-hour practicum and a 600-hour internship experience.

There are currently 238 students enrolled in the CMHC Program.

Between Summer 2023 and Spring 2024, 55 students graduated from the CMHC Program.

The 3-year completion rate of students in the program is 73%.

The job placement rate of graduates from the CMHC program is 100%.

School Counseling (SC)

The SC program is a 69-credit-hour program which includes a 100-hour practicum and a 600-hour internship experience in a school setting.

There are currently 62 students enrolled in the SC Program.

Between Summer 2023 and Spring 2024, 17 students graduated from the SC Program.

The 3-year completion rate of students in the program is 82%.
